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PRISONER: WILLIE WORLEY, YOU DONE LOST YOUR DAM MIND.
MAN YOU THINK THESE PEOPLE ARE GOING TO LET YOU RUN
A BLACK PANTHER PARTY FROM DOWNCREEK CORRECTIONAL
YOU GOT TO BE OUT OF YOUR RABBIT ASS MIND.

NARRATOR: THE PRISONER STOPPED WHEN HE REALIZED
THE MISTAKE THAT HE MADE. EVEN THOUGH WILLIE WORLEY
DID NOT GO FOR BAD, HE DEMANDED A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF
RESPECT. USUALLY IT WAS GRANTED TO HIM OR HE WOULD
MAKE SEVERAL REQUEST BEFORE HE SAW FIT TO RESULT
TO THE PHYSICAL.

PRISONER: DAM MY FAULT, I DIDN'T MEAN NO DISRESPECT
BIG BRA.

WILLIE WORLEY: NONE TAKEN. I AM SERIOUS THOUGH. YOU WILL
SEE.

NARRATOR: IT WOULDN'T BE UNTIL JANUARY 14, 2014 THAT
WILLIE WORLEY JR. AND 6 OTHER PRISONERS WOULD BE KNOWN
AS NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN COMM-
UNITIES 3RD PARTY PROGENY BLACK PANTHERS. BY MARCH OF
2014 PRISONERS AT DOWNCREEK CORRECTIONAL WOULD HAVE
DISTRIBUTED OVER 34,000 FLIERS THROUGH THEIR FAMILY
AND FRIENDS ETC., IN SUPPORT OF 2 U.S. CANDIDATES AND

2 Local Candidates from Charlotte North Carolina.

With big responsibilities come big problems. As Minister of SELF-DEFENSE of North Carolina's BLACK PANTHER Party. Willie Worley gets his first taste of the problems that COMES ALONG with politics.

PRISONER: Willie Worley you stay in the BLACK PANTHER HEADQUARTERS working on your craft don't you?

Willie Worley: IF I don't do it, nobody ELSE will.

PRISONER: You got ANY MORE of those fliers you want me to mail home?

Willie Worley: YEAH, HEAR you go.

Narrator: ANOTHER PRISONER COMES with disturbing NEWS for Willie Worley.

2ND PRISONER: Willie Worley, MAN I just came from SEEING my programer. She wants to know what I sent to DAVIDSON COLLEGE.

Willie Worley: What do you MEAN she want to know?

2nd PRISONER: SHE SAID DAVIDSON COLLEGE CALLED WANTING TO KNOW WHY I SENT THEM KAY HAGAN FLIERS.

Willie Worley: WELL YOU GIVE HER THESE FLIERS AND LET HER KNOW THAT IF SHE HAD ANYMORE QUESTIONS ABOUT THE FLIERS THAT I WOULD BE HAPPY TO ANSWER THEM FOR HER.

1st PRISONER: WILLIE MAN, THEY MIGHT TRY SOME OLE BULL-JIVE ON YOU.

Willie Worley: MY MAN, ONE THING ABOUT WILLIE WORLEY. I RESEARCH EVERYTHING I DO BEFORE I DO IT. IN THE VOTING RIGHTS ACT OF 1965 SECTION 11(b) THERE IS A PART THAT PROTECTS INDIVIDUALS WHO AID OTHERS IN POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS AND PARTICIPATING IN LESS FAVORABLE PARTIES. THEY MAY NOT LIKE THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY, BUT IT IS A PART OF THIS COUNTRY'S POLITICAL STRUCTURE, AND HISTORY.

Narrator: THE 2nd PRISONER IS BACK FROM SEEING HIS PROGRAMER.

2nd PRISONER: WILLIE WORLEY MY PROGRAMER SAID THAT THE CAPTAIN MAY BE COMING TO SEE YOU.

Willie Worley: I LOOK FORWARD TO IT.

Narrator: Willie Worley continued to create his political fliers for dissemination, but deep down he knew that his problems had just begun. Whatever they were, he would deal with them when they were revealed to him. I wouldn't be until a week later that Sargeant Thorne would say something to Willie Worley about the Black Panther Party in the prison cafeteria at Down Creek as he enters

Sgt. Thorne: Hi Worley. How are you do?

Willie Worley: I am just doing. How about yourself?

Sgt. Thorne: They say you are deep into politics. Is that true?

Willie Worley: That all depends on what you consider deep. I am just exercising my rights. Doing a little self reform.

Sgt. Thorne: You a Democrat or Republican.

Willie Worley: Neither.

Sargeant Thorne: Oh you must be an independent.

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Willie Worley: Something like that.

Sgt. Thorne: I SAW ONE OF YOU 3rd Party Black Panther Fliers. My lord you all ARE A REAL PACK of hoodlums. You should NAME YOURSELVES "BLACK Hoodlums" BECAUSE that is what you ARE. I'll BE TO SEE YOU SOON Black Hoodlum. You NEED to stop your political activities you might BE OFFENDING the wrong PEOPLE.

Willie Worley: I AM just EXERCISING my rights UNDER the Voting Rights Act of 1965.

Sgt. Thorne: Your rights? You don't HAVE NO rights. You lost your rights when you WALKED through that gate Buddy Boy.

Willie Worley: Look Sgt Thorne, AS MUCH AS I would like to STAND HERE AND ENTERTAIN your Southern Hospitality from the 1950's, I CAME IN HERE to EAT NOT discuss politics.

Sgt Thorne: Just REMEMBER what I SAID Mr. Worley.

Narrator: Sgt. Thorne WAS REAL bad NEWS. She had just RECENTLY MADE SARGEANT AFTER CLAIMING A PRISONER

ASSAULTED her for NO REASON. But let the truth be told, she had stolen MONEY OFF OF A "GREEN DOT REFILL PACK" FROM A "FRISK" AND "SEARCH" SHE CONDUCTED A WEEK EARLIER ON THE PRISONER. SHE HAD A REPUTATION OF DOING THIS TO A NUMBER OF PRISONERS. PRISONERS ARE AFRAID OF REPORTING HER BECAUSE THEY WOULD SUBJECT THEMSELVES TO A A-18 MISCONDUCT TICKET (LYING OF STAFF). NOT ONLY ARE MISCONDUCT TICKETS 98% UNBEATABLE, THEY ALSO COST THE PRISONER \$10.00 ADMINISTRATION FEES, LOST OF PRIVILEGES SUCH AS CANTEEN, VISITS, AND 15, 30, 45, 60 DAYS ETC., IN SOLITARY CONFINEMENT. MOST PRISONERS WOULD RATHER LET HER CONFISCATE THE GREEN DOT NUMBERS THEN RISKING BATTLING AN UNBEATABLE PRISON MISCONDUCT SYSTEM. SGT THORNE HAD BUILT A REPUTATION ON BUSTING PRISONERS WITH PHONES, DRUGS, CIGARETTES AND THE LIKES. NO ONE WOULD BELIEVE SHE HAD A PASSION FOR STEALING 14 DIGIT NUMBERS WRITTEN ON A PIECE OF PAPER. WILLIE WORLEY KNEW THIS, BUT AS HE SAT IN THE PRISON DINING HALL, HE FOCUSED ON HIS DISSEMINATION PROJECT OF HIS POLITICAL FLIERS. SGT. THORNE WAS THE LAST THING ON HIS MIND UNTIL SHE PAID HIM A VISIT AT HIS LOCKER A.K.A. BLACK PANTHER HEADQUARTERS ON APRIL 13, 2014. BY THIS TIME OVER 34,000 FLIERS WOULD HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED ACROSS NORTH CAROLINA AND CHARLOTTE IN SUPPORT OF KAY HAGAN ALMA ADAMS, VELMA LEAKE, AND ELLA SCARBOROUGH. ALL FOUR WOULD PREVAIL IN THE 2014 PRIMARY ELECTIONS. SGT THORNE

NEW she had to act, AND act fast. The date is April 13, 2014. The first show down between Prison Sargeant Thorne AND North Carolina 3rd Party Minister of Self-Defense Willie Worley. Sargeant Thorne enters "D" Block Housing Unit 6 at Down Creek Correctional. She is escorted by 2 other prison guards one straight the other crooked.

Sgt Thorne: Mr. Worley, Just the inmate I am looking for. I need to conduct a locker search. Bring him a chair and handcuff him. Sit in that chair while I go through your property.

Narrator: The first thing the good ~~one~~ Sgt. Horne picked up was a flier of Thom Tillis and Kay Hagan.

Sgt. Thorne: I like Thom Tillis. What about you boys

Crooked Guard: He's my favorite.

Straight Guard: I think Thom will do a better job in the Senate.

Sargeant Thorne: What's it say... Oh you like Kay Hagan. National Intelligence for African American Communities

3rd Party BLACK PANTHERS. Sounds like some kind of gang. As a matter of fact your whole locker looks like... I don't know let me see.

Narrator: Sargeant Thorne may have been a short pudgy woman, but the way she slung Willie Worley's property out of his locker. You would have sworn that her arm belonged in Major League Baseball. She kept throwing his things on the floor until she saw the 14 digit green dot money numbers. Her face lit up like a christmas tree.

Sgt. Thorne: Mr. Worley. What do we have here? Inmates aren't suppose to have these. I am going to have to confiscate these.

Willie Worley: No what you should do is put those numbers back where you got them from. There is no policy or procedure that say you can't have 14 digit numbers on a piece of paper. It's not U.S. Currency, not a money order not a debt card, not a credit card, it's 14 numbers.

Sgt. Thorne: Still I am going to have to take them.

Willie Worley: You take those number I am going to file a

Complaint.

Sgt. Thorne: It's called AN INMATE GRIEVANCE you idiot.

Willie Worley: No it's called a FEDERAL COMPLAINT with the UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE. You think I don't know about your GREEN DOT THEFT? I AM NOT GOING TO LET YOU JUST TAKE MY MONEY LIKE YOU DID ALL THOSE OTHER PRISONERS.

I KNOW HOW TO LITIGATE. GIVE ME A DC-160 INVENTORY SHEET. WHEN YOU TAKE SOMETHING FROM A PRISONER YOU SUPPOSE TO GIVE THEM AN INVENTORY SHEET STATING EVERYTHING YOU TOOK FROM THE PRISONER.

Sgt. Thorne: That's right, I forgot you ARE A SMART NIGGER!!!
GIVE HIM A DC-160 AND A DC-138 FOR A A-18 MISCONDUCT TICKET.

NARRATOR: SERGEANT THORNE FACE WAS AS RED AS THE HAIR THAT SHE KEPT NEATLY DONE WITH THE PRISONERS GREEN DOT DONATIONS. IN A FEW HOURS WILLIE WORLEY WILL FIND OUT ANOTHER PIECE TO THE PUZZLE OF DOWN CREEK CORRECTIONAL POLITICAL CORRUPTION, WHEN SERGEANT KIGHT SHOCKS HIM WITH YET ANOTHER SURPRISE.

Sgt. Kight: What's wrong Big Guy? Why you slap all those white guys?

(11.)

Willie Worley: MAN you got the wrong dude.

Sgt. Kight: No I got the right dude. Captain Drogers
SAW you on CAMERA, Aint that right CAPTAIN Drogers?

Capt. Drogers: I watched you ASSAULT about 5 white prison-
ERS.

Willie Worley: You CANT find A CAMERA in the world that will
show ME ASSAULTING ANYBODY today

Capt Drogers: Well you should HAVE, BECAUSE you ARE
going to solitary CONFINEMENT for it.

Willie Worley: Is my 3rd Party BLACK PANTHER Political work
that serious that you HAVE to lie to get ME PLACED in
lockup.

Capt. Drogers: They said you WERE smart. You ARE really
pissing people off with those CARTOONS.

Narrator: IN the work of corrections. Prison PERSONNEL
CAN do A little extra duty for A little extra pay. THESE
extra duties could be from stealing GREEN Dot Numbers
like Sgt. Thorne. Or bringing in illegal items, or possibly

From unidentified special interest groups like the ones that landed Capt. Drogers his new high position at the maximum security prison next door to Down Creek Correctional

As for our Minister of Self Defense, he is getting plenty of rest as well as plenty of writing done. He reported every civil rights violation to the U.S. Department of Justice Civil Rights Section. He knew there was forces working beyond the prison system. Willie Worley knew that any kind of physical confrontation amongst more than one prisoner, win loose or draw. Everyone involved are supposed to be placed in solitary confinement for a 15 day investigation. No one was locked up except him. There were no statements to be read but Capt. Droger's and Sgt. Thorne's. Most importantly there was never any video footage produced. Because there wasn't any assault that ever took place. Only a plot to stop the dissemination of 3rd Party Black Panther fliers. The movement was becoming effective in the North Carolina political structure. Prison heads in North Carolina's Capitol would eventually end up making Down Creek drop the charges, placing Willie Worley back on the yard. Over 50 prisoners awaited his arrival wanting to become a 3rd Party Black Panther member. The speech he gave them would be the first address to the

MOVEMENT HE STARTED. IT WOULD BE SENT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO BE KNOWN AS THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM. THE PARTY HAD BASIC POLICIES FOR ALL OF ITS UNELECTABLE MINISTERS TO PROCEED. THE MOST IMPORTANT ONE WAS DISSEMINATION OF 3RD PARTY BLACK PANTHERS AGENDA'S, AND KNOWING NORTH CAROLINA'S VOTING LAWS.

MEANWHILE SGT. THORNE, AND CAPT. RIGGS WAITED FOR THEIR CHANCE TO IMPOSE MORE HATE CRIMES ON WILLIE WORLEY AND 3RD PARTY BLACK PANTHERS. WILLIE WORLEY IS NOW ASSIGNED TO HOUSING UNIT 5 "A" BLOCK AT DOWN CREEK CORRECTIONAL. THE DAY IS OCT 6, 2014 OVER 40,000 PROMOTIONAL FLIERS HAVE BEEN DISSEMINATED, AND MORE PROBLEMS TO COME. WILLIE WORLEY IS ON HIS WAY TO THE DINING HALL TO EAT CHOW WHEN HE IS APPROACHED BY SERGEANT KIGHT.

SERGEANT KIGHT: HEY WORLEY. COME OVER HERE FOR A SECOND.

WILLIE WORLEY: WHAT'S GOOD SARG.

SGT. KIGHT: WHAT'S THAT ON YOUR HEAD?

NARRATOR: SGT. KIGHT WAS REFERRING TO A RASTA HEAD DRESSING THAT WILLIE WORLEY JR. HAS HAD FOR ALMOST 6 YEARS.

Willie Worley: What do you MEAN? You HAVE SEEN ME with this RASTA Crown for 2 YEARS.

SARGEANT Kight: YEah but you ARE NOT RASTA. COME with me so you CAN mail it home or destory it. EITHER ONE.

Narrator: As Sgt. Kight AND Willie Worley exited the dining hall, Sgt. Kight out of the CLEAR blue SKY MADE THE FOLLOWING COMMENT.

"Sgt. Kight: I guess you ARE going to draw A CARTOON OF ME KNOW? I SAW THE CARTOON you drew OF Deputy Director SLASHER. Or ARE you going to work your BLACK PANTHER Voodoo ONE ME?"

Willie Worley: Is this what ALL of this is ABOUT? My political party AND CARTOONS?

Sgt. Kight: You ARE in the way. Pissing A lot of PEOPLE OFF with that BLACK PANTHER Bull. I don't EVEN SEE how it is legal for you to do that. You ARE pulling votes AWAY from good CANDIDATES. Thom Tillis will BEAT her ANYWAY.

Narrator: It was all making sense to Willie Worley now. The fliers that was sent to Davidson College in Cornelius North Carolina, Thom Tillis home base had obviously opposed the Pro-Kay Hagan fliers. They were using dedicated Republicans in prison administrations to get at ole Willie Worley for his 3rd Party Black Panther work, and political cartoons. Willie Worley was not as dumb as most people thought. He knew politics almost as good as, if not better than the elected officials in office. He knew all of his work was politically and legally correct. His work was also sent to the United States Department of Justice as a pre-caution. He knew that their were anti-African Americans at work that were engaging in hate crimes. He would not let that stop him. On October 8, 2014 at breakfast time Willie Worley is faced with yet another crisis that gives the "Prison System Loyalist to the Republican Party" another crack at bringing down the leader of the N.C. 3rd Party Black Panthers.

Prisoner: Big Willie. What did they have for breakfast?

Willie Worley: Same ole Bull. Nothing changed but I got to eat it, or starve to death one. If I had money like you I could skip a few meals like you do.

Prisoner: IF I WAS AS big AS you, I would go to chow AND EAT from the CANTEEN. I KNOW it TAKES ALOT to fill you up.

Narrator: Willie Worley AND the other prisoner shared A laugh. Willie Worley got his things ready to go to the weight pile until SEVERAL prisoners caught his eye. ONE OF them was distracting prison guard Drodgers while the other ONE stole his subway sandwich. As they EASED their way into the cell block, they WENT towards the back of the block to half the sandwich. IN the middle of the sandwich they got the shock of their life. Prison Guard Drodgers would NEVER AGAIN be looked at AS the same goodie-two-shoes prison guard.

1st Prisoner: MAN what is he doing?

2nd Prisoner: Hold ON I AM trying to SEE.

1st Prisoner: Just COME ON, let's EAT it right quick. It will be gone by time he get in here.

Narrator: As the two prisoners half the sandwich AND others ASKED to taste the glory of the stolen

SANDWICH. THEY FOUND SOMETHING SUBWAY DID NOT PUT IN THEIR INGREDIENTS.

1st PRISONER: MAN WHAT'S THAT? IS THAT SOME WEED?

NARRATOR: THE PRISONER PUT IT TO HIS NOSE.

1st PRISONER: NO THAT IS SOME FRIUTY K-2 AND IT LOOKS LIKE ABOUT AN OUNCE OR MORE.

2nd PRISONER: OH SHIT! DRODGERS IS A MULE. LET'S SMOKE, LET'S SMOKE, LET'S SMOKE.

NARRATOR: PRISONERS GATHERED AROUND PUTTING THEIR BID IN FOR WHAT COST LESS THEN A \$100. WHICH PRISON GUARD DRODGERS STAND TO MAKE FIVE OR SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS. FROM THE PRISONER THAT HE'S MULING FOR. THE PRISONER WILL MAKE ROUGHLY \$1500. WILLIE WORLEY WAS AMUSED BY THE PRISONERS INFAMOUS FORTUNE AND FAME. HE WAS MORE AMUSED BY PRISON GUARDS LIKE DRODGERS BEING A MULE. PRISONERS WOULD CHERISH THE REVELATION. JUST THAN, YARD CALL WAS MADE OVER THE LOUD SPEAKER. WILLIE WORLEY HEADED TO THE WEIGHT PILE. AS HE WENT OUT THE DOOR, HE SAW THE DUMB LOOK ON PRISON GUARDS DRODGERS FACE.

Willie Worley: Hey Drodgers. What we got for lunch today?

P/G Drodgers: Worley, COME HERE FOR A SECOND, COME HERE

Narrator: Ole Willie Worley kept on walking and laughing as he made his way to the weight pile to workout. Not thinking twice about P/G Drodgers until he heard him calling over the loud speaker for him to report back to Housing Unit 5 10 minutes later.

Willie Worley: What's up Drodgers?

P/G Drodgers: I NEED you to CLEAN the FANS for me in the block.

Narrator: As Willie Worley was going to CLEAN the FANS, prison guard Drodgers followed.

P/G Drodgers: Where's the SANDWICH Worley? Who got it? I NEED that SANDWICH.

Willie Worley: Is that what you CALLED me back in here for? About A SANDWICH?

P/G Drodgers: I Aint fucking playing with you Worley.
Who got the SANDWICH?

Narrator: Willie Worley laughs at prison guard Drodgers request.

Willie Worley: Your SANDWICH is probably in the garbage CAN. What WAS in it is probably in somebody lungs.

P/G Drodgers: Who took it?

Willie Worley: When a PRISONER RATS ON ANOTHER PRISONER that is the REAL DEFINITION OF A SNITCH. Now if you WANT ME to CLEAN THESE FANS you NEED to go get ME SOME CLEANING RAGS.

P/G Drodgers "F" ing nigger.

Narrator: Willie Worley laughed at the white prison guard display his true feelings. INSTEAD OF going to get the CLEANING RAGS, prison guard Drodgers went to call Sgt. RowN AND told her that Willie Worley REFUSED to CLEAN the FANS AFTER I GAVE him A direct order to do so. Sgt. RowN CAME immediately.

Sgt. RowN : Willie Worley come out here to the officers desk.

Willie Worley: Hey Sgt. RowN.

Sgt. RowN : My officer said he told you to clean those fans and you refused. SENSE you CAN'T follow instruction you ARE fired.

Narrator: Ole Drodgers looked at Willie with a devilish smile. Willie Worley was not impressed by his acts of deception. Now he had more time to dedicate to the 3rd Party Black Panther dissemination campaign.

Willie Worley: Alright. THANK You. I appreciate it.

Narrator: As Willie Worley went back in the dorm, and Sgt. RowN left the Housing Unit. Prison guard Drodgers sent his co-worker to get Willie. She has witnessed the whole ordeal, but has remained silent. Willie Worley wasn't sure if it was because she was new, or she owned stock in the drug muling. He thought it was a little of both.

P/G McRAY : Worley. Drodgers want you out here at the desk.

Willie Worley: Tell him I SAID... No I'll tell him.

Narrator: BEFORE Willie could say anything Drodgers put in ANOTHER plea.

P/G Drodgers: Look Worley. Just tell me who took the SANDWICH AND I'll SEE if I CAN get your job back.

Willie Worley: First off, I don't want the job back. You did me a FAVOR. SECONDLY I wouldn't tell you shit ANYWAY. Go find it yourself AND good luck with that.

Narrator: Willie Worley watched as prison guard Drodgers looked for SOMETHING ANYTHING he could USE AS A WEAPON to ASSIST him in his RAGE. THE CLOSEST thing he could grab WAS A FLASHLIGHT from BEHIND the desk. Prison guard Drodgers picked it up AND charged towards ole Willie Worley. HE waited right until Drodgers got within A FEW FEET of him AND Willie side STEPPED out of the way AND Drodgers fell clumsily to the floor. Prison guard McRAY frantically told the 283. pound 6'4 Willie Worley to go in the dorm.

Willie Worley: Your clumsy ASS CAN'T EVEN ASSAULT A PRISONER with a flashlight without FALLING ON your FACE,

AND YOU WANT TO MULE DRUGS.

P/G Mc RAY: PLEASE WORLEY GO IN YOUR BLOCK, PLEASE.

NARRATOR: AS WILLIE WORLEY WENT INTO HIS CELL BLOCK, HE KNEW THE WHOLE INCIDENT WOULD NOT END GOOD. TO MANY PRISONERS SEEN IT. THERE WOULD BE STORIES. DIFFERENT STORIES. STORIES TO COVER UP A DRUG DEALING PRISON GUARD THAT HARASSED BLACK PRISONERS ALL DAY. AS HE WAS LOST IN THOUGHT, HE HEARD A PRISONER SAY.

PRISONER: HERE THEY COME BIG WILLIE. DAM! THEY ARE COMING LIKE SOMEBODY DIED.

NARRATOR: THE FIRST PERSON WILLIE WORLEY SAW WAS CAPT. RIGGS.

CAPT RIGGS: WHAT HAPPENED?

NARRATOR: WILLIE WORLEY SAID NOTHING HE KNEW CAPT. RIGGS HE KNEW THAT THEY WAS ALL IN THE SAME PLOT. EACH ONE WASHING THE OTHERS HANDS IN AN ENDLESS ACT OF CORRUPTION.

Willie Worley would end up getting 180's long-

- term for prison guard Drodgers on intensive control. 75 days ran into his sentence, as well as 90 extra days of just wait for the outcome in solitary confinement.

Prison guard Drodgers was promoted to Sargeant and transferred to the close custody facility next door to Down Creek.

Sargeant Thorne was moved to special operations where she had little interaction with prisoners making it hard for her to steal "Green Dot Numbers"

P/G Mc Ray is said to have taken an oath of silence about the whole incident.

Captain Drodgers was promoted to Assistant Superintendent at the close custody facility next door.

Captain Riggs continues to regulate a "Black Market" while portraying to combat gang violence, drugs, phones, and tobacco.

Our nation's prison system are a product of many dysfunctions because of our failure to address

the REAL problems that cripples the individuals rehabilitation "the INCARCERATOR." INCARCERATORS HAVE DESIGNED SO MANY WAYS OF CREATING BLACK MARKETS FOR THEIR STAFF TO MAKE MONEY OF OUR NATIONS INCARCERATED PERSON THAT IT IS TROUBLING. THAT'S WHY I GUESS SO MANY WERE EAGER TO STOP THE 3rd PARTY BLACK PANTHER MOVEMENT. THAT AND HATE. IT WAS A CHANCE FOR THEM TO CLEAN UP THEIR VERY DIRTY DEEDS IN THE EYES OF THEIR BOSSES. THEY FORGOT ONE THING. YOU CAN'T STOP WHAT IS DESTINE TO HAPPEN.
