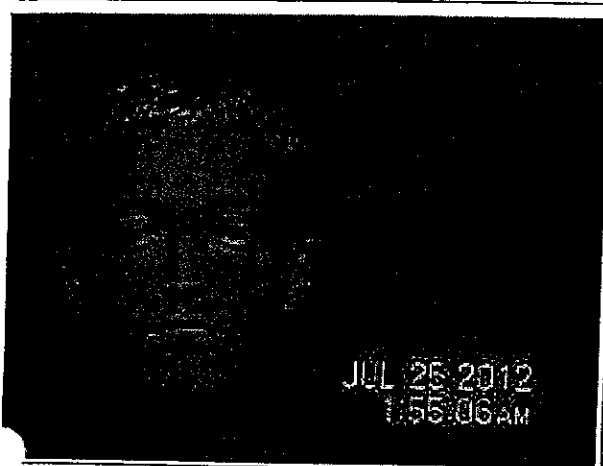

## "Friends"

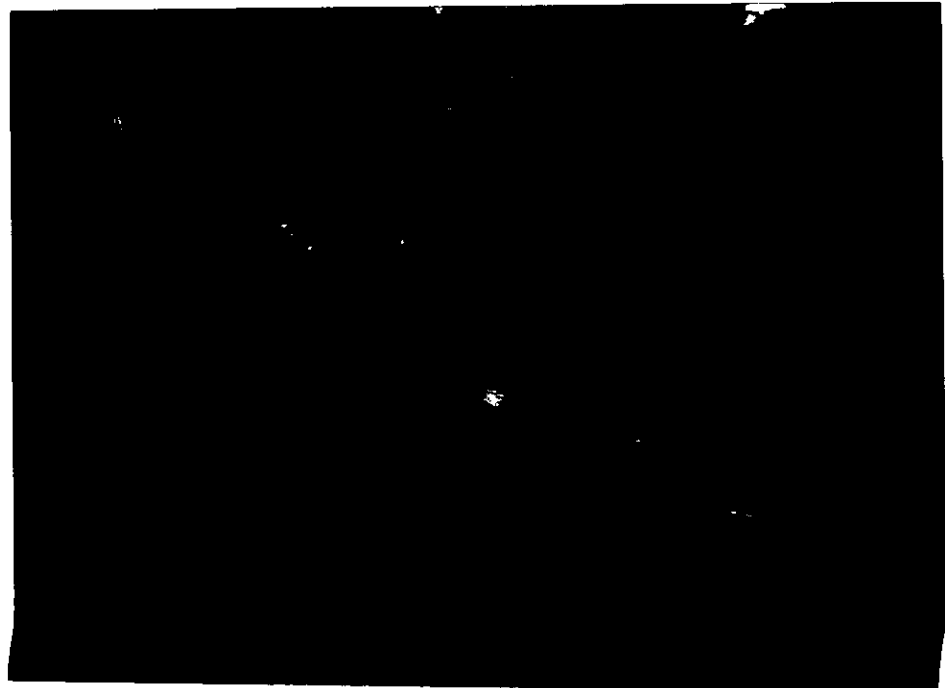


